**ORDER**

The additional meeting of the Board of Studies in Physical Education vide paper read as (1) above has recommended to grant attendance for the students who participate in Sports Competitions, Coaching Camps and Selection trials (including days of journey), subject to lowering of the minimum attendance from 75% to 50%.

The University Level Monitoring Committee (ULMC) vide paper read as (2) above, considered the recommendation of the Board of Studies in Physical Education and suggested to grant attendance to the students who participate in Sports Competitions, Coaching Camps and selection trials (including days of journey), subject to lowering of the minimum attendance form 75% to 50%. The Principals of the Colleges, concerned shall sanction attendance on recommendation of the Head of the Physical Education Department of the Colleges after due verification of the necessary documents relating to the same. The students who avail the above provision shall not be eligible for further condonation as applicable in the case of other students as envisaged under clause 7.11 of the Regulations relating to the First degree Programmes under CBCS system.

The Vice-Chancellor, subject o reporting to the Academic Council, has approved the recommendations of the University Level Monitoring Committee (ULMC) to lower the minimum attendance from 75% to 50% (including days of journey) for the students who participate in Sports Competitions, Coaching Camps and Selection trials and such persons shall not be eligible for further condonation as applicable in the case of other students, as envisaged under clause 7.11 of the Regulations relating to the First Degree Programmes under CBCS system, as recommended by the Board of Studies in Physical Education.
