**ORDER**

In modification to 'Clause 12' of paper (1) read above, reference cited (2) above was issued so that, "*the maximum grace marks awarded to the students of professional and post-graduate courses shall not exceed 5%*".

Vide paper read as (3) above, the members of the faculty of the Physical Education endorsed the resolution that the "Maximum Grace Marks awarded to the PG Students shall be limited to 8% of the total marks for each paper".

As per paper read as (4) above, "The Standing Committee of the Academic Council resolved to recommend for Enhancing the grace marks to the Students of PG and Professional courses to 8% and to extend the benefit for both the semesters of the eligible year from 2015-2016 onwards".

Sanction has therefore been accorded by the Vice-Chancellor to implement the above decision of the Standing Committee of the Academic Council for enhancing the ***grace marks to the students of PG and Professional courses to 8% and to extend the benefit for both the semesters of the eligible year from 2015-2016 onwards.***

### ORDER

The Vice-Chancellor has approved the recommendations of the University Level Monitoring Committee (ULMC) regarding the Guidelines for the award of Grace Marks to the candidates of First Degree Programmes under CBCS system for their achievements in Sports/Arts/NCC/NSS from 2013 admissions and U O read as paper (1) had been issued in this regard.

The University Level Monitoring Committee vide paper read as (2) above recommended to modify Clause 2 of the Guidelines for awarding grace marks for achievements in Sports/Arts/NCC/NSS from the academic year 2013-14 as follows:

**“The total eligible percentage of grace marks shall be given for both the semesters separately to students for their performance in Sports/Arts/NCC/NSS and the permissible distribution of such grace marks eligible shall also be confined within the courses (papers) of the respective semesters”.**

The Vice Chancellor has approved the above recommendations of the ULMC to modify Clause 2 of the Guidelines for awarding grace marks for achievements in Sports/Arts/NCC/NSS from the academic year 2013-14.

The Clause 2 of the Guidelines issued vide paper read as (1) stands modified to this extent.

**Consolidated Guidelines for Awarding Grace Marks for Achievements in Sports / Arts /  
NSS / NCC from the Academic Year 2013-2014**

1. Grace marks shall be awarded to Under Graduate Programmes under CBCS system.
2. Grace Marks can be given for all the courses of the semester programme in a year. For semester programme the percentage shall be based on the total maximum marks of either of the two Semesters. The total available Grace Marks can be distributed for both semesters in a year.
3. In the case of semester Programmes the academic year shall be from 1<sup>st</sup> June to 31<sup>st</sup> May.
4. Grace Marks shall be awarded to the candidate on the basis of his/her performance in the respective academic year. The student shall claim the Grace Marks within one year after the end of the academic year but prior to the issue of Degree Certificate (eg. The claim for 2013-14 shall be made before 31<sup>st</sup> May 2015)
5. Only regular bonafide students shall be eligible for Grace Marks.
6. Grace Marks shall be awarded for one additional chance including improvement and also to courses of the supplementary examinations in the next immediate chance only. This includes readmitted candidates also. In awarding Grace Marks to the supplementary examinations it shall be given only to the courses of the performing year of the candidate and at the same percentage applicable there to in the performing year.
7. Grace Marks shall be given for the written examinations. But if the marks of a candidate are below the required minimum for a pass in internal / viva / practical's, Grace Marks can be redistributed to these to get only a pass).
8. Grace marks can be redistributed enabling the candidate to get a pass in the examination in a course(s) among the whole range of examinations in the performing year.
9. Grace Marks awarded shall not be considered for ranking and the total marks after awarding Grace Marks shall be 1 (one) mark less than the total marks of the third rank / position. But the grace marks awarded will not be considered for issuing position certificate.
10. The Director, Physical Education should furnish the list of Sports / Games events approved by the National Federations / Associations and approved by the Kerala Sports Council and recommendations made only for approved events.
11. Deaf and Dumb candidates with disability of 40% or above on production of a Medical Certificate obtained from a Medical Board are only eligible to receive the grace marks for Sports performance.
12. Application with all relevant documents and attested copies of certificates for Grace marks shall be submitted to the Director of Physical Education of the University through the Principal / Director of Physical Education / HOD of Physical Education of the College concerned for verification. The Director of Physical Education of the University may sent the approved list to the Controller of Examinations of the University for awarding Grace Marks.
13. In the case of NCC Cadets application with all relevant documents and attested copies of certificates for grace marks shall be submitted through the Group Commander, NCC Group by the institution and forwarded to the Controller of Examinations after proper recommendations of eligible grace marks.
14. In the case of Arts / NSS participants the Director of Students Services shall finalise the list of eligible students for grace marks after collecting the applications with all relevant documents from the Principals and forward the recommendations to the Controller of Examinations every year.

II. The maximum grace marks awarded to a student in a year for all the activities put together shall not exceed 25%.

III. Course wise distribution shall be followed and Grace Marks need not be awarded to a student if he/she secures less than 10% of the maximum marks for that theory course (external).

IV. The basic criteria for the award of Grace Marks shall be representing the University when called upon so. In case the University has not called upon the candidates to represent the University, Grace Marks shall be awarded only to those candidates who have participated in the Kerala University Intercollegiate competitions / Selection Trials in that particular academic year except those candidates who secure places in the National Competitions and those who represent the Nation in International competitions, approved by the National Federations, Kerala Sports Council and University of Kerala.

ORDER

The additional meeting of the Board of Studies in Physical Education vide paper read as (1) above has recommended to grant attendance for the students who participate in Sports Competitions, Coaching camps and Selection trials (including the days of journey), subject to lowering of the minimum attendance from 75% to 50%.

The University Level Monitoring Committee (ULMC) vide paper read as (2) above, considered the recommendation of the Board of Studies in Physical Education and suggested to grant attendance to the students who participate in Sports Competitions, Coaching Camps and selection trials (including days of journey), subject to lowering of the minimum attendance from 75% to 50%. The Principals of the Colleges, concerned shall sanction attendance on recommendation of the Head of the Physical Education Department of the Colleges after due verification of the necessary documents relating to the same. The students who avail the above provision shall not be eligible for further condonation as applicable in the case of other students as envisaged under clause 7.11 of the Regulations relating to the First degree Programmes under CBCS system.

The Vice- Chancellor, subject of reporting to the Academic Council, has approved the recommendations of the University Level Monitoring Committee (ULMC) to lower the minimum attendance from 75% to 50% ( including days of journey) for the students who participate in Sports Competitions, Coaching Camps and Selection trials and such persons not be eligible for further condonation as applicable in the case of other students, as envisaged under clause 7.11 of the Regulations relating to the First degree Programmes under CBCS system, as recommended by the Board of Studies in physical Education.
